## WATERFOWL ENCLOSURE

The brook in Dawlish has been home to the Black Swans since the early 1900s. There are also other waterfowl such as Chinese and African Geese that can be seen enjoying this tranquil space. Within the enclosure you can see various species including Carolina Ducks, Crested Bantam Ducks, Call Ducks, Bahama Pintail Ducks, Mandarin Ducks, and Black East Indies. The breeding season starts in March and chicks are usually available to see in the viewing window from March - September. You can sponsor a Black Swan, Goose or Duck. 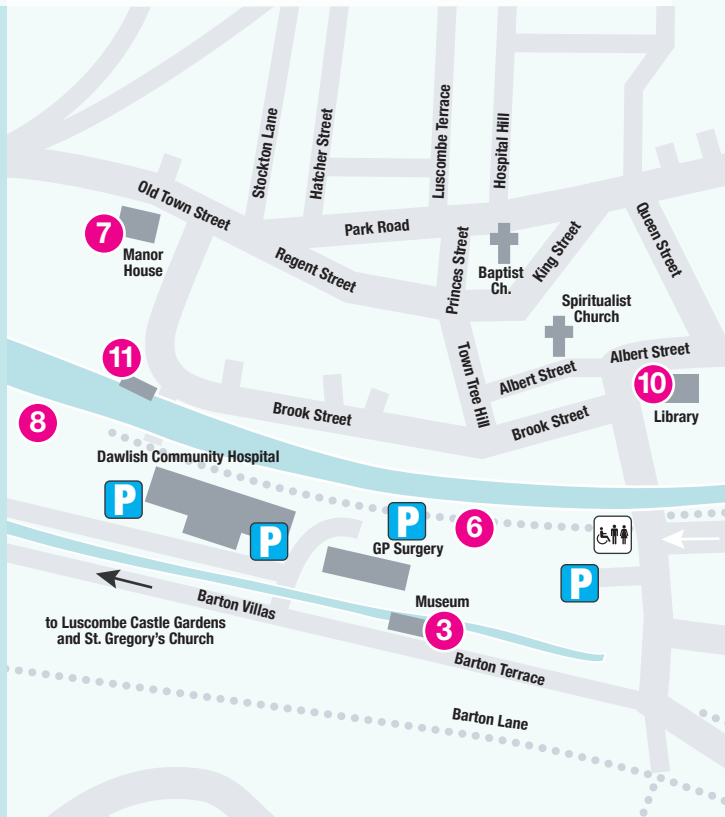

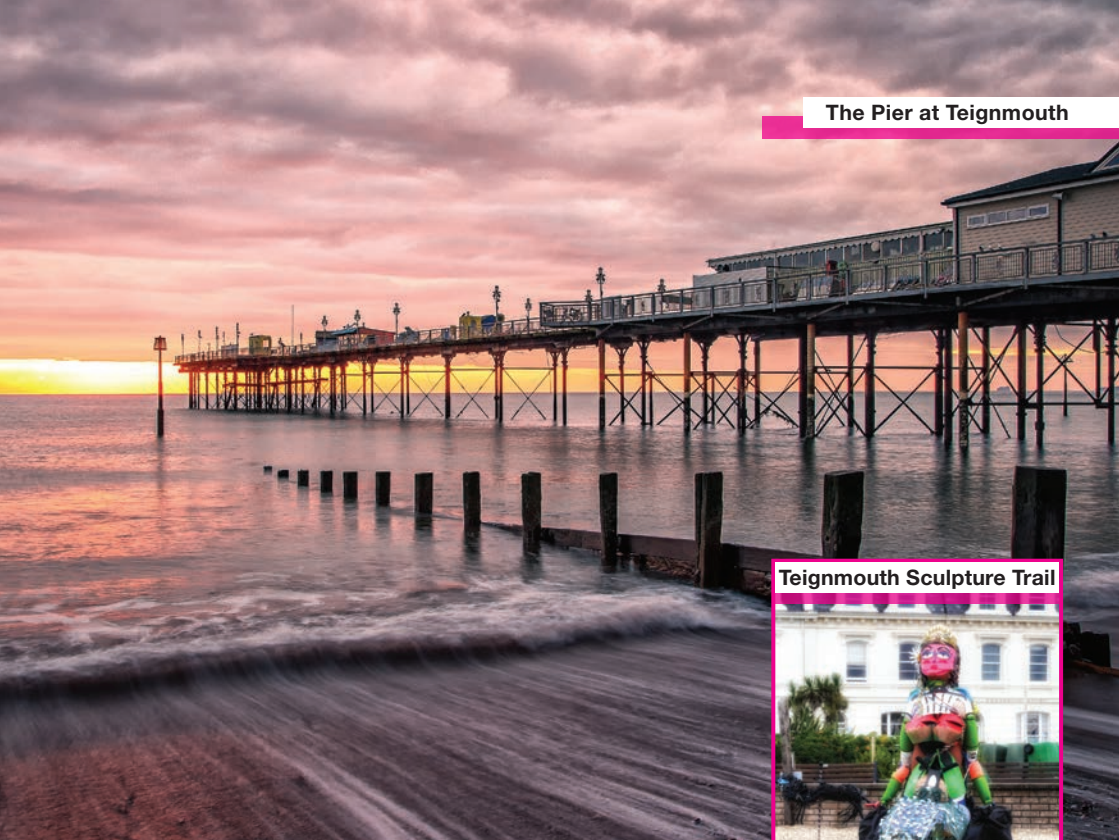

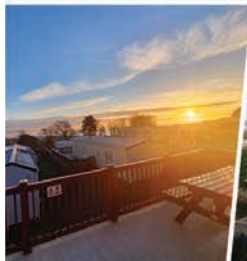
