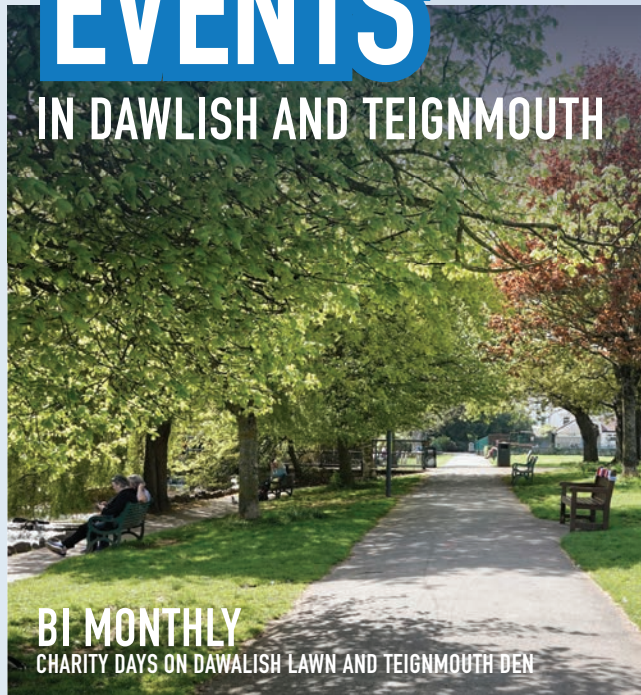
GENERAL INFORMATION
